Definitions

Earnings – Money received by an individual for personal services and denominated as wages, salary, commissions, or otherwise.

Exemption Amount – A dollar threshold allowed by law to reduce the amount of income that would otherwise be garnished.

Household – Two or more individuals who reside together in a single home.

Household Income – The combined gross income of all adult (18 years of age or older) members in a household.

Increased Exemption Amount – A dollar threshold greater than the exemption amount (defined above) that reduces the amount of income that would otherwise be garnished. Individuals who qualify as the sole financial provider of their household are eligible for an increased exemption amount.

Sole Financial Provider – The only provider of income to a household consisting of two or more people.
