GRANT — money that you don't need to pay back



HOW TO APPLY FOR THE AEG

STEP 1: Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at **STUDENTAID.GOV** and select at least one Alaska institution.

STEP 2: Create an Alaska Student Aid Portal (ASAP) account at **ACPE.ALASKA.GOV/ASAP**. Available funds are awarded to eligible applicants in priority order.

STEP 3: The award notice is sent to the email listed on the FAFSA.

IMPORTANT: *you must take action or the award will be canceled. First notifications will be made on or after May 1st.*

STEP 4: Because your school has to confirm qualifying attendance, make sure you are fully admitted and enrolled **BY AUGUST 1ST**.
